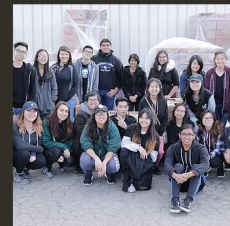
DIVISIONAL COUNCIL MEETINGS (DCMs)

HISTORY of CSUF CKI

2005-2006 - Genesis
